Slide 9, 10 and 11 - Progress. CLP and EWM graphs. CLP treatment was completed in May EWM Treatment: -East Basin – no significant EQM found to treat -West Basin – no EWM found to treat Water clarity is better CLID has applied for an Anoka County grant for AIS reimbursement for 2020 Slide 12 and 13 CLP and EWM inspection and treatment maps discussed.

Slide 14 and 15. Proposed Lake Treatment Plan and Cost for 2021 Continue early spring CLP treatment as necessary. Continue EWM spot treatment in East and West Basins. Grants not a guarantee but a reinstatement of the MN DNR AIS Grant may occur due to an increase of boat license fees. Permit application by January 2021 April or eaerly May CLP treatment, 50 acres (\$7,500). EWM treatment, 100 acres (\$15,000) New Transect survey or AIS delineation (\$5,000) TOTAL: \$27,500

Motion for Special Tax Assessment

Assessment of \$25 for the current property owners of record for a total of \$11,175. Motion made by Jean Bury and seconded by Brian Aronson. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion for the 2020 Proposed Expenses

2020 expenses of \$35,400 including administration potential expenses. Motion made by Mike Bury and seconded by Jeff Wunderlich. Motion passed unanimously.

Follow-up discussion was held to pass a \$549 building assessment. Motion moved by Jeff Welciek and seconded by Chris Larson. Motion passed unanimously.
